

### English

We will study a range of different genres during this term. In our fiction unit, we will be focusing on 'stories about feelings' which the children will then have a go at writing for themselves. We will also explore newspaper articles and diary entries. The children will also be introduced to some poetry.

### Maths

In maths, we will start the term with a focus on number and place value to secure the children's understanding in this area of maths. We will then explore adding and subtracting on a number line. Other areas of learning will include fractions, measuring and multiplication and division.

### Science

In science, we will be learning about the seasons and the human body; looking closely at the body parts that are associated with each sense. We will continue our work on the properties of materials, linking this to our learning about The Great Fire of London.

### Topic

In geography, we will be exploring the countries that make up the United Kingdom and their capital cities, with a focus on London.

In history, we will learn about all of the key events that happened in The Great Fire of London. We will explore what the houses were made from and compare them to houses nowadays. We will also examine changes to the fire service and fire safety over the years.

### RE

Our focus in RE this term is 'Places in Christianity'. We will explore places that are special to Christians as well as the features that make these places special.

### Art and Design

In design, we will be designing and making our own Stuart houses. We will also have a go at making some bread when we travel back in time to the Pudding Lane bakery.

In art we will make some sky line pictures as well as some 'flame art' in the style of Andy Warhol.
