


## **INSTRUMENT OF GOVERNMENT : VOLUNTARY AIDED SCHOOLS**

1. The name of the school is **Sywell Church of England Voluntary Aided Primary School**
2. The school is a voluntary aided school
3. The name of the governing body is **"The governing body of Sywell Church of England Voluntary Aided Primary School"**
4. The governing body shall consist of:
  - a) **1** Head Teacher
  - b) **2** parent governors (to be elected)
  - c) **1** LA governor
  - d) **1** staff governor (to be elected)
  - e) **8** foundation governors
  - f) **1** co-opted governor
5. Total number of governors is **14**
6. Foundation Governors are appointed by Peterborough Diocese Board of Education
7. Sywell CE Aided Primary school in partnership with home, parish the diocese and the wider community provides a caring environment for the spiritual academic moral and social development of its members. The school promotes Christian Values through the experience of Christian belief and practice it offers to all its pupils in accordance with the principles of the Church of England ( which includes respecting other faiths) The school works in partnership with the Church at Parish and Diocesan level.
8. This instrument of Government comes into effect on **14 January 2015**
9. This instrument was made by order of Northamptonshire Local Authority on **28 July 2015**
