

### Pupil Premium Academic Year 2016-2017

Sywell CEVA Primary School receives Pupil Premium funding for each child that is currently registered to receive Free School Meals, and for any child that has been previously registered to receive Free School Meals within the last six years (known as Ever6 children). Additionally, any child that is designated as looked after (LAC), or previously looked after (post LAC) also qualifies for Pupil Premium. There is also a Pupil Premium for children of service personnel.

From September 2016, the premium was £1320.00 for FSM and Ever 6 pupils, £1,900.00 for LAC and post LAC and £300.00 for service children.

From the pupil census of January 2016 there were 7 FSM/Ever 6 pupils on roll, and 2 post LAC which gave Sywell a total Pupil Premium Funding of £14,940.00.

We use Pupil Premium to support our students with their academic attainment and progress. We also utilise the funding to help pay for support from outside agencies, extra-curricular clubs, residential visits and uniform.
