


English

We will explore writing a range of different genres that are all based around our topic this term. We will write two non-fiction texts based on the texts of *'The Street Beneath My Feet'* and *'Earthquakes'*. After half term, we will explore writing fiction based on *'The Stone Age Boy'* that will link with our learning in History. Supporting your child's work in learning their spellings at home is highly encouraged. Reading at home at least 3 times a week with your child is also a school expectation that we will continue to monitor closely this term.



Science

In Science this term, we will be exploring the units 'Forces and Magnets' as well as 'Rocks.' Within these units, the children will take part in various experiments and practical activities to develop their knowledge and understanding.



PSHCE

In our PSHCE lessons, children will be exploring the themes "Relationships" and "Changing Me".

Computing

This term, we will explore databases, simulations, graphing and presenting.



Music

In our Music lessons, we will explore the *Charanga* units of *'Bringing us together'* and *'Reflect, rewind, replay'*. The children will explore performing, listening to, reviewing and evaluating music across a range of styles and genres. Children will learn to sing and to use their voices, to create and compose music on their own and with others.



Our focus in our French lessons will be learning some basic language for French transport.

French

Humanities

We will start this topic learning about volcanoes and earthquakes in our Geography lessons. Children will learn about the different parts of a volcano as well as how earthquakes are created.

We will then learn about the Stone Age in our History lessons. Children will learn about changes in Britain from the Stone Age to the Iron Age.



Art/D&T

This unit will begin by designing and creating magnetic toys/games to link to our learning in Science. After this, we will explore different sketching, drawing and painting techniques to create some 'Stone Age' artwork.



Maths

Our main focus areas this term are:

Decimals (including money)

Time

Statistics

Geometry: Properties of shape (including Yr 4 Position and Direction)



We will also continue with our weekly times tables tests. You can support your child at home by practising these with them and encouraging them to log on to TTRockstars. Please also see the KIRFS documents that need regular rehearsal at home this term.

RE

To start this topic, we focus on the religion of Christianity to complete work to answer the question 'When Jesus left, what was the impact of Pentecost'. We will then revisit our learning from the Spring term on Hinduism and continue to answer the question 'What does it mean to be a Hindu in Britain today?'

PE

Our PE days this term will be on Tuesdays. During the first half term, children will be completing activities to develop their basketball skills. After half term, we will then focus developing their skills in rounders and cricket.
